

PhD, Master, Bachelor student Scholarships for field experiences in financial inclusion 1st Call for Applications - 2015

We invite PhD, Master and Bachelor students enrolled at universities in the European Union to submit applications to the "University Meets Microfinance" (UMM) Scholarship Program for ongoing or planned field experiences on financial inclusion topics. The field experience must still be ongoing at the time of the scholarship deadline to be eligible.

UMM Scholarships Program for Field Experiences

Scholarships of up to 1500 EUR are granted to students enrolled at universities in the European Union to cover travel and/or accommodation expenses during the field experience.

- PhD students are eligible to apply for scholarships for field research in the frame of their PhD research.
- Master and Bachelor students are eligible to apply for scholarships for field research in the frame of their thesis research or internships in developing countries

Each application is evaluated by a professor and a practitioner. The final score is the average of the two evaluations. Successful candidates are informed six weeks after the submission deadline. Outstanding applicants may be invited to share the results of their research during UMM events, in UMM newsletters or on the UMM website.
