The goal of InFiNe.lu Scholarship Programme is to enable InFiNe.lu members to strengthen expertise in Luxembourg to advance financial inclusion.

InFiNe.lu offers **2 grants** to employees from an InFiNe.lu member organisation for the following elearning courses:

- 1 grant for the Certified Expert in Microfinance e-learning course;
- 1 grant for the Certified Expert in SME Finance e-learning course.

These 2 e-learning courses take place from September 2017 to February 2018. The scholarship offered by InFiNe.lu covers the tuition and final exam fees for both courses.

1 Certified Expert in Microfinance / e-learning course

The Frankfurt School of Finance and Management Certified Expert in Microfinance e-learning course is a 6 month programme. During the programme, you will get a better understanding of, *inter alia*, the microfinance business, the risks related to it, how to manage micro-credits and micro-savings. The programme will discuss also financial and social performance management.

Tuition fee is EUR 650 and final exam fee is EUR 50.

2 Certified Expert in SME Finance / e-learning course

Access to SME finance has become a key priority in developing and transition countries. The Frankfurt School of Finance and Management Certified Expert in SME finance e-learning course is a 6 month programme. During the programme, you will learn how to manage SME Finance as an independent product line/customer segment within a financial institution. There will be a focus on



the credit risk assessment based on clients' individual analysis although all management levels will be taught.

3 InFiNe.lu scholarship application

3.1 Eligibility criteria

InFiNe.lu scholarships are open to the following candidate:

- Employee working for an organisation member of InFiNe.lu at the time of the application and at the time of the training;
- Fluency in English.

3.2 Guidelines to apply for InFiNe.lu scholarships

The candidate must submit the following documents in PDF format (in separate files):

- a Curriculum Vitæ of maximum 2 pages in English (pdf document entitled Last Name_CV);
- a cover letter of max 2 pages in English (pdf document entitled Last Name _Cover letter)
 demonstrating:
 - the link between her/his professional background and her/his participation to the chosen e-learning course;
 - how the participation in the programme will be useful to his/her professional development
- a letter of recommendation from the employer (pdf document entitled Last Name_Recommendation letter)

Applications must be submitted mentioning clearly the e-learning course for which you are applying (Certified Expert in Microfinance or Certified Expert in SME Finance) no later than the 6th of June 2017, 4pm by email to:

3.3 Selection Process and Notification

- All applications will be reviewed by InFiNe.lu;
- A selection committee composed of representatives from InFiNe.lu members will select the successful candidate;
- Shortlisted applicant will be invited for an in-person Skype or telephone interview with the selection committee;
- The successful candidate will be directly notified after the selection committee.

Important note:

- The Frankfurt School of Finance and Management e-learning courses are 6 months online training. Therefore, the successful candidates commit themselves to follow the whole programme and to pass the final examination.

- pass the final examination of the e-learning courses and provides a copy of the certificates;
- submit a max. 5 pages report about the e-learning course and present it to the InFiNe.lu board:
- make a presentation to InFiNe.lu members after the completion of the e-learning courses.
